Sølvsberget, Stavanger kulturhus was established in 1987, and has ever since then been a key institution in Stavanger's cultural life. Sølvsberget is situated in the middle of the city centre, and has more than 1,7 million visitors a year.

Sølvsberget, Stavanger kulturhus contains a wide range of cultural activities. The main contributors are Stavanger public library, one of the largest public libraries in Norway, and SF Kino, Stavanger's movie theatre.

is located on the ground floor. A café serving hot and cold food and beverages.

- **Choco Boco**

is located on the ground floor. A café serving hot and cold food and beverages.

- **Stavanger music and film library**
